Subject: Human right of refugees on EU soil

Yesterday thousands of refugees and migrants were forced to flee again. This time it was the devastating fire that made them flee the overcrowded Moria camp. The camp with an initial capacity of 3000 places has been totally destroyed, leaving 13.000 people with nowhere to sleep. There is no time to waste. The situation in camp Moria on Lesbos was already unsustainable - the lack of hygiene, overcrowding and terrible conditions in which refugees find themselves are leading to increased human suffering.

1. Is the Commission willing and ready to provide emergency support and humanitarian aid in response to the disaster that has left 13.000 people in a crisis situation on Lesbos?
2. How will the Commission make sure that humanitarian conditions of vulnerable refugees on EU soil are met according the universal and indivisible rights set out in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR), the European Convention on Human Rights (ECHR) and other international conventions?
